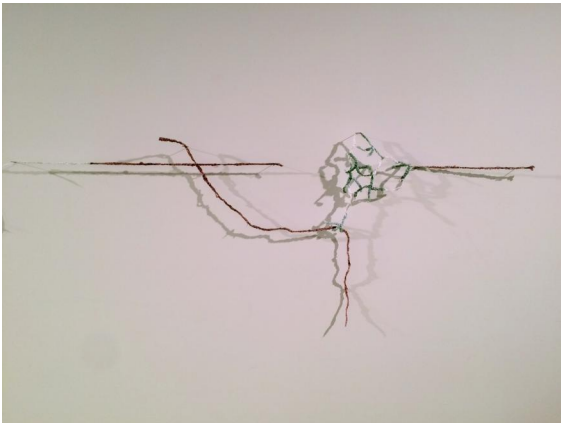


## *Deirdre Fox Featured at Two Local Art Centers*
